Jonathan E. Fielding has served over forty years in public health leadership positions. He served for sixteen years as Public Health Director and Health Officer of Los Angeles County. He chaired the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary's expert advisory group on the 2020 Healthy People Project and co-chairs the advisory committee for the 2030 Project. He also currently chairs the US Community Preventive Services Task Force, was a founding member of the US Clinical Preventive Services Task Force, and cofounded the Big Cities Health Coalition. He is Editor of the Annual Review of Public Health and a Distinguished Professor of Health Policy and Management and Pediatrics, in the Fielding School of Public Health and the Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA. Dr. Fielding founded the UCLA Center for Health Advancement, which models policies and programs to cost-effectively improve health and health equity, education, and criminal justice systems for populations and disadvantaged subgroups.
