We resonate with the following goals for our residents:

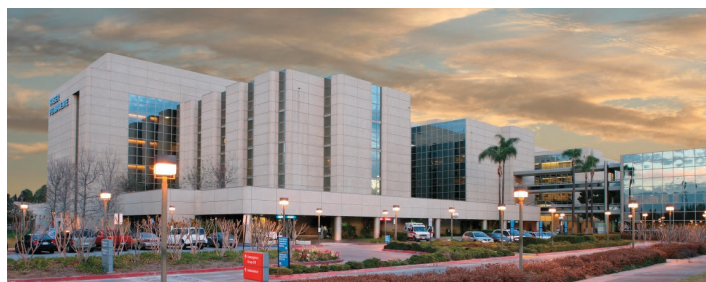
1) Foster habits of life-long learning and its inherent benefits

- Excellent fellowship or job placement upon graduation in all settings

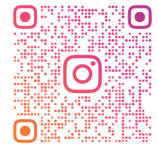
